ABC analysis is derived from the term " The Pareto Principle " named after an Italian economist Vilfredo Pareto, also called 80/20 rule. This principle suggests that 80% of the total output is generated only by 20% of the valuable efforts. When it comes to stock or inventory management, ABC analysis typically segregates inventory into three categories based on its revenue and control measures required: A is 20% of items with 80% of total revenue and hence asks for tight control; B is 30% ...
