Context Clues are words in and around a sentence containing an unknown word. The clues help us understand the meaning of the unfamiliar word. Knowing about Context Clues is especially useful for content area reading. Content area reading is reading that you do in different subject areas such as social studies, science and even math!

A word's context is the words, phrases, and sentences that surround it. If you look closely at the context of an unknown word, you often get clues about that words meaning. Look for: Synonyms Antonyms Definitions Examples Read Surrounding Sentences When ALL ELSE FAILS use a Dictionary Look for Synonyms Watch for words that repeat the same ...

### Context Clues - Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools

There are several different context clues you can use to help you figure out unfamiliar words. Authors often use punctuation clues to help the reader. Punctuation clues might include commas, dashes, or parentheses. Examples: Mary retained, kept, the deed to her mother's house. I wonder if that fruit is edible, able to be eaten. Types of context clues There are at least four kinds of context clues that are quite common.

Context clues are hints in the sentence that help good readers figure out the meanings of unfamiliar words. When we look at the "context" of a word, we look at how it is being used. Based on how these words are used, and on our knowledge of the other words in the sentence, we make an educated prediction as to what the challenging vocabulary word may mean.
