Income Guidelines For Cash Assistance

To be considered a needy family, the countable income of a family may not exceed: 130% of the current federal poverty level for families in which the head-of-household is a non-parent relative requesting Cash Assistance only for the dependent children. Example: A grandparent requests CA only for a grandchild.

Cash Assistance (CA) Income Eligibility Guidelines ...

Gross monthly income includes unearned income – for example, Social Security benefits – and earned income – such as payment for work- before taxes. Since July 1, 2016, the gross monthly income limit for a family of three has been \$840. This typically increases annually.

Income and Deductions - Gross income must be less than 185% of the Federal Poverty level and countable income can't be higher than the payment standard for the family size. Individuals get a \$90 deduction from their gross earned income.

DFA PROGRAM NET MONTHLY INCOME LIMITS

Welfare or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) provides cash for a limited time to low-income families working toward self-sufficiency. TANF may also offer non-cash benefits such as child care and job training. Supplemental Security Income (SSI) provides cash to low-income seniors and low-income adults and kids with disabilities.

A person can receive TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families) for a total of 60 months in a lifetime. This is true if a person is: Period(s) of TANF receipt need not be consecutive to count toward the 60-month limit. You may receive Cash Assistance that does not count against your TANF 60-month limit.
