Gross Motor (physical) skills are those which require whole body movement and which involve the large (core stabilising) muscles of the body to perform everyday functions, such as standing, walking, running, and sitting upright. It also includes eye-hand coordination skills such as ball skills (throwing, catching, kicking).

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Monthly Movement Activities - The OT Toolbox

Gross motor skills Development – The sequence of development is the same in all children, but the rate of development varies from child to child. Development progresses in the “Cephalocaudal” direction (means from head to toe). The first step towards walking is the development of head control – of strength in the neck muscles.

Gross motor development involves the development of the large muscles in the child’s body. These muscles allow us to sit, stand, walk and run, among other activities. Fine motor development involves the small muscles of the body, especially in the hand. Motor development also involves how well children’s muscles work.

Motor skills are movements and actions of the muscles. Typically, they are categorized into eighteen groups: Gross motor skills – require the use of large muscle groups to perform tasks like walking, balancing, and crawling. The skill required is not extensive and therefore are usually associated with continuous tasks.

A child's motor development is a continuous process from fetal life to maturity, evolving from development of the central and peripheral nervous systems. Fetal movement serves as the foundation for newborn motor skills, through the emergence of tone, primitive reflexes, and general fetal movements.

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
