### Protected Areas in Switzerland - IUCN

The oldest protected areas are some of the 41 federal hunting reserves in the alpine areas. These were inaugurated in 1876 in order to prevent excessive depletion of wildlife by hunting, ie, they were game reserves where hunting was prohibited. Many of these still exist today, but have been integrated into the new, larger, protected areas.

The Jungfrau-Aletsch protected area is located in south-western Switzerland between the cantons of Berne and Valais. It is a mountainous region in the easternmost side of the Bernese Alps, containing the northern wall of Jungfrau and Eiger, and the largest glaciated area in western Eurasia, comprising the Aletsch Glacier. The Jungfrau-Aletsch protected area is the first World Natural Heritage site in the Alps; it was inscribed in 2001.

To safeguard this natural heritage the Federal Council and the people of Switzerland have adopted a series of concrete measures in recent years.

### Key aspects of environmental protection in Switzerland ...

Switzerland's animal life is primarily Alpine, but a mixture of species familiar to southern and north-central Europe is also found. Animal life is protected, except during a brief annual hunting season. Alpine tourists may observe marmots, which live in the high meadows, and chamois. Large herds of the round ibex, which had died out in the Swiss Alps and has since been reintroduced, populate several areas, especially in the Bernina region of Graubünden (canton) and in the Saastal of Valais.
