The thicker the thread, the more visible your stitches will appear in the fabric. Weight is numbered on the spool: A small number correlates to a thicker thread; a bigger number correlates to a finer thread. The three most common sizes of thread in the U.S. are 30, 40, and 50 wt. (For comparison, all-purpose thread is usually 40 wt.)

Thread size - If you find numbers on your sewing machine thread you should know that 60-90 is the average sewing thread size (for cotton and synthetic thread) and 50-60 for silk threads and the lower the thread number, the thicker the thread; you should not even attempt to use any thread which is lower than 20 size on your sewing machine. A size 30 thread can be used for sewing thick fabrics.

Elastic Thread. Elastic thread is used in the sewing machine bobbin for shirring by machine. Be sure to wind the elastic thread by hand onto your bobbing without stretching it. Silk Thread. Silk thread is perfect when sewing with silk and other fine fabrics, as well as with wool for tailoring because it is easily molded into shape with an iron.

Sewing 101: Needle and Thread Guide

For thread, we recommend either V-69, V-92, V-138 polyester thread and Heavy Tenara with a size #18 or #20 needle. If using Tenara ® or Sailrite ® Lifetime Thread (formerly Profilen ®), sew your Sunbrella with a size #18 or #20 needle. We also include an overview of the different types of thread and their prime uses.

V-69 is the heaviest commercial size recommended for home sewing machines. Heavier threads make your stitching more visible. The thread size measures the thread's thickness. If another weight is given for thread (like ounces), it refers to the amount of thread on the spool. Thread tends to get stronger as it gets heavier.

Essential guide to sewing machine threads - Gathered

It is used for machine and hand embroidery. Rayon and silk embroidery thread works best with lightweight to medium-weight fabrics. Elastic Thread. Elastic thread has a high stretch and is used for gathering, smocking, shirring, and creating small details. Metallic Thread. Metallic thread is made with a polyester core that's wrapped with foil/tinsel.

Traveling from the spool holder across the top of the machine, look for a minimum of one thread guide. Insert the thread in the thread guide (s). Now look for a tension mechanism. Bring the thread down to the tension mechanism, slip the thread between the metal disks of the tension mechanism, and travel back upward with the thread.
