Types of Buffer Solution. There are two buffer forms, acid buffer, and base buffer. Acid Buffer. A buffer solution that contains large quantities of a weak acid, and its salt with a strong base, is called an acid buffer. On the acidic side such buffer solutions have pH, i.e. pH is below 7 at 298 K. The equation gives the pH of an acid buffer.

You can choose between two types of buffers: acidic buffer solutions, which contain a weak acid and its conjugate base, or alkaline buffer solutions, which contain a weak base and its conjugate acid. Acidic buffer solutions have a pH below 7 and usually contain an associated salt as a conjugate base.

A buffer is able to resist pH change because the two components (conjugate acid and conjugate base) are both present in appreciable amounts at equilibrium and are able to neutralize small amounts of other acids and bases (in the form of H₃O⁺ and OH⁻) when they are added to the solution. To clarify this effect, we can consider the simple example of a Hydrofluoric Acid (HF) and Sodium Fluoride (NaF) buffer.

Buffer solutions are solutions that resist changes in pH (by resisting changes in hydronium ion and hydroxide ion concentrations) upon addition of small amounts of acid or base, or upon dilution. They usually consist of a weak acid and its conjugate base, or, less commonly, a weak base and its conjugate acid.

Acidic buffer solutions An acidic buffer solution is simply one which has a pH less than 7. Acidic buffer solutions are commonly made from a weak acid and one of its salts - often a sodium salt. A common example would be a mixture of ethanoic acid and sodium ethanoate in solution.
